### 1. Premise

• Up to 4 (four) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis to chosen applicant(s).

#### 2. Requirements

- Applicant must be pursuing a career in healthcare and a graduate of Carbon County School District 1 or 2.
  - Definition of career in healthcare- some qualifying career areas include, but are not limited to, the following: nursing, physicians/mid-levels, anesthesia, physical therapy, occupational therapy, respiratory therapy, imaging, laboratory, billing and coding, and healthcare administration. Careers related to veterinary/animal sciences are not eligible.
- Applicant shall demonstrate previous or current community and/or involvement in extra-curricular activities.
- Applicant shall be at least 17 years of age and be accepted to a full-time program, but not yet attending because the established start date of the program has not arrived <u>OR</u> applicant shall be at least 17 years of age and be accepted to and attending a full-time program at an accredited institution of learning.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicant shall submit a completed application as outlined under "Part 1."
- Applicant shall submit all documents as outlined under "Part 2."

#### 3. Selection

- Applications will be reviewed by a panel of MHCC Foundation Board Members and winners will be selected based on criteria set forth in the requirements of this scholarship.
- Recipients will be notified via mail and email. Recipient and families will be invited to a MHCC Foundation Board Meeting for awards presentation in May.
